Risks and Typologic Inter-Agency Group (RTIG) Supported by Public-Private Partnerships



AML/CFT Industry Partnership (ACIP)

AML/CFT SC: Sets AML/CFT Policy Direction

IAC: Facilitates policy coordination and implementation of AML/CFT policy

RTIG: Oversees the identification, assessment, and mitigation of terrorism financing (TF) risks

Public-Private Partnerships: Leverages platforms such as ACIP



- Legal Frameworks: Terrorism (Suppression of Financing) Act and Internal Security Act
- Targeted Financial Sanctions: IMC-TD designates and oversees the listing of terrorists, and the freezing of terrorist assets



- Comprehensive Sectoral AML/CFT Requirements: AML/CFT obligations for regulated entities
- Industrial Engagements: Raises sectoral awareness of AML/CFT obligations
- Risk-Based Surveillance and Supervision:
 Ensures implementation of AML/CFT measures

Investigates TF

Suspicious Transac Reporting Office (STRO)

Collects and analyses financial intelligence, including TF-related suspicious transaction reports



Internal Security Department (ISD)

Collects and analyses intelligence relating to TF



Attorney-General's Chambers (AGC)

Prosecutes TF cases

Law enforcement agencies also actively collaborate with industry partners through ACIP's CFT Operational Group



International Partnerships and Cooperation

- Provide and seek assistance to and from other jurisdictions: Extraditions, mutual legal assistance, and exchanges of information
- Participation in international and regional platforms, such as:
 Financial Action Task Force (FATF)
 Financial Intelligence Consultative Group (FICG)
 INTERPOL's Project PACIFIC Working Group
